# Harmony For All Fund (Also called the Music Access Fund) - Information

## Why give?

Music participation enriches students' lives far beyond the classroom. It also has several additional costs for students and their families. Many cannot afford these costs and, as a result, miss out on the enriching experience and extensive benefits. The Music Access Fund will support these costs for Memorial and North High School students and families in need.

## How many children will benefit from this fund?

Music Access Fund will potentially enable up to $\mathbf{3 0}$ new children each year to participate in a music ensemble of their choice.

How much will this fund give out each year?
The annual grant amount to each high school will be approximately $\$ 2,500$, depending on the amount in the fund. We anticipate this amount increasing as the fund grows.

What grade levels will this fund impact?
Grades 9-12 with the anticipation that eventually it will include grades 6-8.

## What does the school district pay for?

- Activity fee for students who qualify for free/reduced lunch
- Marching band uniforms
