Why give?

Music participation enriches students' lives far beyond the classroom. It also has several additional costs for students and their families. Many cannot afford these costs and, as a result, miss out on the enriching experience and extensive benefits. The Music Access Fund will support these costs for Memorial and North High School students and families in need.

How many children will benefit from this fund?

Music Access Fund will potentially enable up to **30** new children each year to participate in a music ensemble of their choice.

How much will this fund give out each year?

The annual grant amount to each high school will be approximately \$2,500, depending on the amount in the fund. We anticipate this amount increasing as the fund grows.

What grade levels will this fund impact?

Grades 9-12 with the anticipation that eventually it will include grades 6-8.

What does the school district pay for?

- Activity fee for students who qualify for free/reduced lunch
- Marching band uniforms

What will this fund help pay for?

- Costumes
- Dress blacks for concerts
- Instrument rental
- Shoes
- Travel expenses
- Lessons
